

## **SCORING CRITERIA STAGE PRESENCE** (Total: 30 Points)

## 1. Teaching Subject Passion (10 Points)

- 10-9 Points: Clearly expresses a deep passion for their subject, providing strong examples of how it influences their teaching and student engagement.
- 8-7 Points: Shows enthusiasm for the subject with good examples but lacks depth or clarity in explanation.
- 6-5 Points: Mentions passion, doesn't provide concrete examples of how it impacts teaching.
- 4-0 Points: Shows little to no enthusiasm or connection to the subject.

## 2. Clear & Effective Communication (10 Points)

- 10-9 Points: Ideas are well-structured, easy to follow, and engaging; uses storytelling, real-life examples, or analogies effectively.
- 8-7 Points: Communicates clearly but may lack engagement or strong examples.
- 6-5 Points: Message is understandable but lacks structure or depth.
- 4-0 Points: Communication is unclear, disorganized, or difficult to follow.

## 3. Impact & Engagement (10 Points)

- 10-9 Points: Captivates the audience, making the subject matter exciting and relatable.
- 8-7 Points: Engages the audience but could be more dynamic.
- 6-5 Points: Some engagement but lacks energy or personal connection.
- 4-0 Points: Fails to connect with the audience; lacks enthusiasm or clarity.

# **SCORING CRITERIA PRESENTATION & PERSONAL IMAGE** (Total: 30 Points)

#### 1. Presentation & Personal Image (10 Points)

- 10-9 Points: Dress well, coordinated attire, and polished overall.
- 8-7 Points: Dressed well with appropriate attire, but minor improvements could be made.
- 6-5 Points: Dressed ok and lacks refinement or coordination.
- 4-0 Points: Inappropriate attire, or untidy overall appearance.

#### 2. Confidence & Poise (10 Points)

- 10-9 Points: Displays outstanding confidence, composure, and grace in posture, movement, and expressions.
- 8-7 Points: Shows confidence and good posture but may have minor lapses in poise.
- 6-5 Points: Somewhat confident but may appear nervous or unsure at times.
- 4-0 Points: Lacks confidence, appears uncomfortable or unprepared.

# 3. Authenticity & Charisma (10 Points)

- 10-9 Points: Exudes authenticity, warmth, and a natural presence that draws others in.
- 8-7 Points: Has a good presence but may need more energy or uniqueness.
- 6-5 Points: Tries to be engaging but lacks a strong personal connection.
- 4-0 Points: Lacks charisma or authenticity, appears overly rehearsed or disengaged.



# **SCORING CRITERIA JUDGES INTERVIEW** (Total: 40 Points)

## 1. Clarity & Articulation (10 Points)

- 10-9 Points: Speaks clearly, confidently, and fluently; well-structured responses with no filler words or hesitations.
- 8-7 Points: Clear and articulate but has minor hesitations or slightly unstructured answers.
- 6-5 Points: Understandable but lacks confidence, structure, or fluency.
- 4-0 Points: Mumbles, stumbles over words, or has difficulty expressing thoughts clearly.

# 2. Authenticity & Personality (10 Points)

- 10-9 Points: Answers feel genuine, showcasing a unique personality and personal values.
- 8-7 Points: Shows personality but may feel slightly rehearsed or reserved.
- 6-5 Points: Attempts to show personality but lacks depth or authenticity.
- 4-0 Points: Responses feel robotic, insincere, or lack personal connection.

# 3. Content & Substance (10 Points)

- 10-9 Points: Thoughtful, well-developed answers that align with personal values and Pride community.
- 8-7 Points: Answers are solid but could be more in-depth or impactful.
- 6-5 Points: Somewhat relevant but lacks strong content or depth.
- 4-0 Points: Off-topic, vague, or lacks meaningful substance.

#### 4. Confidence & Poise (10 Points)

- 10-9 Points: Maintains excellent posture, eye contact, and composure; appears relaxed and in control.
- 8-7 Points: Generally confident but may show slight nervousness or hesitation.
- 6-5 Points: Shows some nerves, lacks strong stage presence or control.
- 4-0 Points: Appears anxious, unprepared, or overly uncomfortable.
